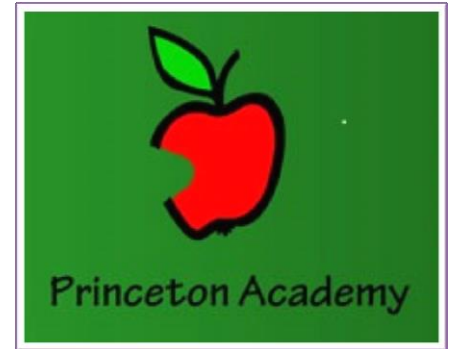

A grant from the Colorado Department of Human Services was awarded to the Rocky Mountain Prevention Research Center at the University of Colorado Denver to work with Princeton Academy Preschool children to implement The Culture of Wellness in Preschools (COWP) program.
